Dear Friends

Over the course of this weekend, ordinations will be taking place across the country, and including at Guildford Cathedral. Some candidates will be preparing to be ordained as Deacons, and others as Priests within the Lord's church. It's always a very special season, with bells ringing out up and down the county; and cathedrals packed to the gunnels with family, friends and supporters. And we may well hear the Guildford Cathedral bells ringing during our 10am service!

This season is known as 'Peter-tide', and services often focus on the apostle Peter, who was set apart as the first leader of the early Church. Jesus said to him, 'You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church; and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it' (Matthew 16:18). It was a huge responsibility – just as many Ordinands will be sensing, as they prepare for Saturday (as Priests) or Sunday (as Deacons). Peter succeeded at times, and failed at others. He proclaimed Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ; and also denied him at Jesus' point of greatest need. He could be loving and committed, rash and hasty – but Jesus chose him, just as he was.

Today we'll be thinking about Peter's life and ministry, and what it teaches us about our own call to be disciples of Jesus.
