Dear Friends

If you were one of Jesus' first disciples, what would you ask him?

"What was it like, in the beginning?"

"Did you keep that gold, frankincense and myrrh?"

"Does heaven have sofas or is it all chairs?"

(...It's probably a good job I wasn't one of the first disciples...)

"Lord, teach us to pray," asks a disciple in today's reading. And Jesus answers, with a portion of the Lord's prayer and the encouragement to ask, search and knock on that door.

In other words, faith is an active thing. Believing in God isn't just a one-time decision, but a lifelong relationship. And like all relationships, conversation keeps it alive.

Prayer is that conversation - and if we ask God, he listens. If we search, we'll find. If we knock on a door, it'll be answered and opened.

What's on our hearts today, that we'd like to ask God about, or ask for help with, or ask for an answer to?

Perhaps we could begin with the request of that disciple in today's reading, and simply ask: "Lord, teach me to pray."
