

Role description for young (under 18) Children's Church Leader at All Saints

Role: To lead and encourage the faith of children within Children's Church

Role Requirements:

To be:

To have sense of God's call to work with children or young people. To be a person of prayer, compassion and understanding and a person who leads in a gracious, Christ-like manner; and who treats each member of Children's Church with respect and dignity, as a unique individual created in the image of God.

To do:

- To attend services at All Saints regularly, and have a good understanding of the worshipping life of the church
- To be Confirmed, or be considering Confirmation in the near future

To support the Children's Church leaders in any/all of the following – as agreed with the Children's Church Coordinator

- To welcome the children, or young people, and to encourage them to grow in their faith in God
- To let the children, or young people, know how important they are as individuals and as part of the church
- To be a role model for the children of what it means to live a Christian life
- To use the agreed teaching materials, as appropriate, to encourage their understanding of God
- To arrive early to help set up and to tidy away afterwards
- To work cooperatively with others to plan sessions in advance
- To attend Children's Church planning meetings
- To be aware of any allergies the children may have
- To adhere to Children's Church budget
- To be willing to share your contact details with the Children's Church Co-ordinator, with your own parent's consent; or to be contacted via your parents, if this is preferred
- To receive support and guidance from the Children's Church Co-ordinator on all aspects of the All Saints

 complete a 'Registration and Permission form' on an annual basis
